5 Reasons Every Christian
needs to be Sharing the
Gospel message...

1**We will all face Jesus**

The Bible is clear that all Christians will face Jesus at the judgement seat of Christ (2 Cor 5:10). This is not a judgement of our sins as these have been taken by Him. This is the judgement of our life as Christians... how much we allowed the Holy Spirit to use our time, resources and talents to extend the Kingdom of God.

One key aspect of this judgement will be what we did with the Gospel message. Did we hide it and keep it to ourselves or did we allow the Holy Spirit to use us to promote it, spread it and speak it out to those around us?

2**How else will people hear?**

How are non-Christians going to hear the Gospel message if Christians don't speak to them?

The apostle Paul asks all Christians the rhetorical question 'How can they hear unless someone tells them?' (Romans 10:14)

Living a good life or being friendly is good but is never going to explain why Jesus came to earth, died on a cross, was risen from the dead etc. These truths and how a person must respond to them needs to be explained using words.

3**Those without Jesus go to ?**

The Bible is clear that those without Jesus go to hell. It is described by Jesus as a place of weeping, wailing and gnashing of teeth (Matt: 8:12, Matt: 13.42)...not a good combination.

We must keep this truth in mind as we go about our day to day lives. Everyone around us will one day die and face God. They will end up in heaven or in hell for eternity.

Jesus wants us to help prepare others for that day by sharing the Gospel with them.

4**Jesus final commands**

Jesus gave final commands to His disciples and all future followers when He commanded them to go into all the world and preach the Gospel and make disciples. (Mark 16:15, Matt 28: 18-20)

This is known as the Great Commission for a reason. It is a primary reason we are left on the earth and what the Church is meant to be working to complete.

Jesus wants all Christians to be active in fulfilling the Great Commission by sharing the Gospel.
